Daisuke Hayashi Director and Japan Chief Representative Phoenix Property Investors

Mr. Hayashi heads Phoenix's Japan office and oversees Phoenix's investments in Japan. He has over 20 years of experience in real estate private equity and investment banking, having compiled a successful track record during that time. Mr. Hayashi joined Phoenix from Aetos, where he served for 10 years as the Managing Director and Head of the Acquisitions Group.
