Robert Lie Managing Director CITIC Capital, Real Estate Group

Dr Robert T. Lie became Managing Director, CITIC Capital Real Estate Group in May 2012. He was previously Managing Director of Redevco Asia and member of the Redevco Board. From 1996 Robert Lie held various positions at ING Real Estate Investment Management in The Hague, Singapore and Hong Kong and was CEO of ING REIM Asia from 2004 to 2008. He was responsible for integrating Rodamco Asia into ING REIM.

Robert Lie previously worked as a lecturer at the faculty of Economics of the University of Amsterdam and at the City University Business School in London (now known as CASS Business School). Robert Lie holds a BA and MA in Economic Geography and a Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Amsterdam. He is a member of several professional organizations. He is a founder and board member of ANREV and member of the Advisory Board of Sparinvest Property Investors.



Ada Choi, CFA Senior Director CBRE Research

Ada acts as the leader of real estate capital market analytics within the Asia Pacific team to assist the delivery of research-based strategic advice to key real estate investment clients. She is responsible for leading the team to monitor investment activity, including capital flow, price movement and investment strategy.
